Pilgrimage to Pentecost

Pilgrimage to Pentecost is a course designed to guide participants on a spiritual pilgrimage towards Pentecost.

As pilgrims on this journey, we will be following the example of Our Lady and the first disciples, who prepared for the first Pentecost together, by reflecting on the Scriptures and devoting themselves to prayer.

The Pilgrimage to Pentecost runs during Eastertide from the 2nd Sunday of Easter (Divine Mercy Sunday) to the Saturday after Pentecost Sunday. It has the components of:

- 1. a Course Booklet: a specially written booklet, grounded in Scripture and Tradition, with daily Scripture-based reflections and a Pentecost Novena for the 9 days leading up to Pentecost Sunday.
- 2. Six weekly sessions: each with a video consisting of worship, a short talk and a testimony professionally filmed.
- 3. In-person Pilgrimage Day: we are encouraging every 'pilgrim' to attend the Archdiocesan Jubilee Celebration Day at The Friars, Aylesford on Pentecost Saturday, 7 June which has further details on the page overleaf..

We will run it here in our parish as hub for other parishes in the area to join in. It will be on either Tuesday or Thursday evenings but will be confirmed soon. For further details please speak to Father Joe or Cathy Anderson.
